1. PROJECT CONTEXT

The Ministry of Environment (MMA), in cooperation with the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO), implements the Project to the Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Equipment Manufacturing Sector — RAC Project stage 2 of the HPMP Brazil. The stage 2 of the HPMP Brazil was approved at the 75th ExCom (Nov 2015) aiming at reducing HCFC consumption in Brazil by 35% until 2020, and by 45% until 2021.

The project to be implemented by UNIDO addresses the Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Equipment Manufacturing Sector – RAC Project and is coordinated by the Ministry of the Environment (MMA). The RAC Project aims eliminating the HCFC-22 of the production process of companies manufacturing refrigeration and air conditioning equipment. The beneficiary companies will receive technical and financial support to phase out HCFC-22 from their production process and adopt a zero-potential ozone depletion (ODP) technology alternative and low impact to the global climate system.

This Term of Reference will serve the air conditioner project that will provide technical assistance to companies that manufacture residential air conditioners equipment with consumption of HCFC-22.

2. ORGANIZATIONAL CONTEXT

The United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) is a specialized agency of the United Nations. Its mandate is to promote and accelerate inclusive and sustainable industrial development in developing countries and economies in transition, and work towards improving living conditions in the world's poorest countries by drawing on its combined global resources and expertise. Under the stage 2 of the HPMP Brazil, UNIDO was the multilateral agency designated by the Brazilian Government to implement the RAC Project and its subprojects.

For this contract, the consultant will work in cooperation with the national team within the Project Management Unit — PMU at UNIDO in Brazil, and under the supervision of the local project manager and the national project coordinator. His duties shall be performed in accordance with applicable rules and regulations of UNIDO and this Term of Reference.

3. OBJECTIVE OF THIS TOR

The purpose of this Term of Reference is to provide systematized information to the air conditioning sector in Brazil, related to the technical discussion on the Montreal Protocol instances, in special the Reports of the Technology and Economic Assessment Panel. The consultant should prepare a document systematizing up-to-date information on the use of alternative refrigerants in residential air conditioners, including case studies of developed projects. The final document will be made available to the participants of the Air Conditioning Meeting, to be held on November 28, in Brasilia, and will be placed free for access on the MMA website. The consultant will work under the supervision of the local project manager and the national project coordinator in Brazil.

4. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. To elaborate a technical document on the most up-to-date Reports of the Technology and Economic Assessment Panel of the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer, systematizing information on low-GWP technologies/equipment for residential air conditioner;

8. PROOF OF REQUIREMENTS AND REFERENCES

Professional Experience: Experience must be proven through a signed curriculum and at least the place where the services were performed, the role performed, the period of completion, and the name and telephone number of the contact person. The curriculum vitae may include other documents to assist in proving professional experience, such as detailed information on the scope of services performed, studies or reports made, etc.

9. MONITORING AND OUTPUTS

During the term of the contract, the consultant will be supervised and shall work closely with the PMU/UNIDO Brazil and meet the delivery schedule of the outputs as defined in the contract to be signed.

At the end of the activities, the consultant will be responsible for presenting the material obtained and developed throughout the duration of the work carried out.

The Consultant shall keep confidential all information obtained under penalty of applicable sanctions.

10. PRODUCT AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Payment will be made in instalments referring to the activities listed **in item 4** (Duties and Responsibilities) when the product is presented, analysed and accepted.
